

Basic instructions for building a baseplate. Choose the materials you will need from our classroom materials corner.

Materials you will need:

1. Cardboard or wooden base
2. Green, light blue and brown markers
3. Glue or glue stick
4. Pair of scissors
5. Razor or sandpaper (to clean the edges of the papers)

Instructions:

1. Cut a piece of cardboard for the base of the model. You can paint the cardboard green for the fields and blue for the water.
2. Cut small pieces of cardboard or paper towel and glue them to the green surface to make the fields.
3. Add small details such as small animals, flowers or other plants to complete the natural landscape of the baseplate.

Tips:

- Use quick drying glue to speed up the construction process.
- Make sure to keep the scale and realism of the natural landscape you want to represent.
- You can also use paints or markers to give natural colors to your materials.
